For advisors and prospective advisors: LinePoint collects information that you voluntarily provide, which may include your name, email address, phone number, city/state, assets under advisement, and other relevant professional details. This information is used solely for the purpose of assessing potential partnerships, evaluating services, and contacting you with relevant information regarding our offerings. LinePoint does not sell or share this information with any third parties unless required by law. We employ industry-standard security measures to protect the personal information you provide. However, no system is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee the absolute security of your information. You have the right to request access to the personal information we hold about you, correct inaccuracies, or request its deletion by contacting LinePoint at compliance@linepointpartners.com.

For clients and prospective clients: LinePoint does not collect personal non-public information about you through this website ("Website"); however, LinePoint may collect information from you on application forms, agreements, general client profile questionnaires, and other related forms or documents received or processed in relation to services we provide. We also may collect information from other sources.

We do not track your activity across third-party websites to provide targeted advertising. However, we may track your interactions with our Website to help us improve our content and functionality.

Our Commitment to You. LinePoint Partners & Co., LLC ("LinePoint") is committed to safeguarding the use of personal information of our clients (also referred to as "you" and "your") that we obtain as your investment adviser, as described here in our Privacy Policy ("Policy").

Our relationship with you is our most important asset. We understand that you have entrusted us with your private information, and we do everything that we can to maintain that trust. LinePoint (also referred to as "we", "our" and "us") protects the security and confidentiality of the personal information we have and implements controls to ensure that such information is used for proper business purposes in connection with the management or servicing of our relationship with you.

LinePoint does not sell your non-public personal information to anyone. Nor do we provide such information to others except for discrete and reasonable business purposes in connection with the servicing and management of our relationship with you, as discussed below.

Details of our approach to privacy and how your personal non-public information is collected and used are set forth in this Policy.

Why you need to know? Registered Investment Advisers ("RIAs") must share some of your personal information in the course of servicing your account. Federal and state laws give you the right to limit some of this sharing and require RIAs to disclose how we collect, share, and protect your personal information.

How do we protect your information? To safeguard your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we maintain physical, procedural and electronic security measures. These include such safeguards as secure passwords, encrypted file storage and a secure office environment. Our technology vendors provide security and access control over personal information and have policies over the transmission of data. Our associates are trained on their responsibilities to protect clients' personal information.

We require third parties that assist in providing our services to you to protect the personal information they receive from us.



How do we share your information? An RIA shares client personal information to effectively implement its services. In the section below, we list some reasons we may share your personal information.
